

CTC Court Etiquette

Effective 14 October 2024

- All players are kindly requested to be considerate when courts are in use by using the exterior designated gates to access an available court.
- Be respectful and avoid interrupting play on any other courts.
- Play two if a ball comes across during play and refrain from displaying emotions and inappropriate language.
- For the safety of all players, wait until there is a break in play before requesting the return of a ball from another court. Do not cross onto or behind another court to retrieve a ball. Do not return a ball whilst play is in progress on another court.
- Only sporting equipment related to tennis is permitted on the courts.
- Correct footwear is to be worn on the courts.
- No glassware is to be taken on the court.
- Due to the close proximity of local residences, please be mindful of any excess noise levels from the court area.
- Clear all of your belongings, including garbage, from the court at the end of your session. Return any balls that aren't yours to the front desk.
- Be considerate of all players and their desire to enjoy a game of tennis. The game of tennis depends on courtesy and fairness. Sportsperson-like, respectful, and courteous behaviour is required at all times on both the courts, and within and around the Clubhouse.
- The CTC Board retains discretion to suspend or cancel memberships should a member not adhere to the expected behaviour and etiquette outlined above.
